WE TAKE THE HEALTH OF OUR COMMUNITY SERIOUSLY.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, we are implementing the following protocols:

Instead of handshakes, we will greet you with a "Hello" and a wave or nod. All staff members are performing hand hygiene protocols before and after all appointments.

We are regularly cleaning and disinfecting doorknobs, desk/work surfaces, and equipment.

We are providing alcohol-based hand sanitizer to our visitors and staff, in the Reception area and in our internal office.

If visitors wish to wash their hands with soap and water, they may ask Reception for a bathroom key.

WHAT ARE MY INTERVIEW OPTIONS?

We are offering video interviews as an alternative to in-person meetings. We will also coordinate video interviews between employers and candidates, wherever possible.

PREVENTION TIPS

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after being in public, or after sneezing, blowing your nose, or coughing. If soap and water is not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- If you cough/sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue, or use the inside of your elbow. Throw out used tissues, and immediately wash your hands.
- Regularly clean and disinfect surfaces in your home, especially areas that people touch a lot
- If you or someone you live with isn't feeling well (especially with possible COVID-19 symptoms), limit your shared spaces.

PLEASE NOTE:

1 IF YOU HAVE A FEVER AND/OR NEW ONSET OF COUGH OR DIFFICULTY BREATHING,

AND

2 IN THE 14 DAYS BEFORE SYMPTOM ONSET, YOU HAVE:

- been to a COVID-19 impacted area, or
- been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19, or
- been in close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has been to a COVID-19 impacted area
